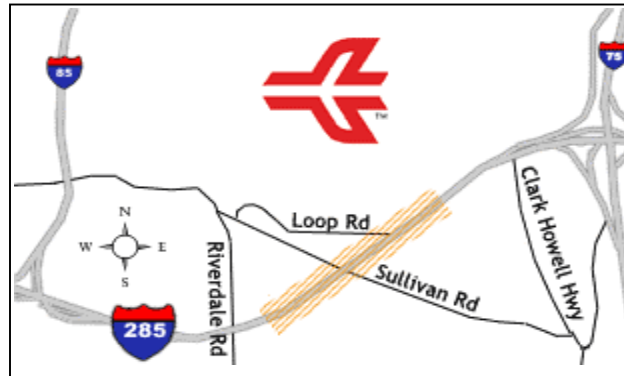


I-285 Exit/Entrance Ramp Closures March 9-14th

Georgia DOT's Runway Construction at Airport Progresses



Georgia Department of Transportation crews continue to work towards the completion of the 5th runway at Hartsfield-Jackson International Airport. To safely complete this project on time, changes to the traffic flow on Interstate 285 are necessary. In addition, traffic will be permanently re-routed onto the newly-relocated section of I-285.

From March 9-14, 2005, these exit and entrance ramps will be closed:

- The entrance ramp from SR 139 (Jonesboro Road) to I-285 eastbound will be closed.
- The exit ramp from I-285 eastbound to Clark Howell Highway will be closed.
- The ramps will close on Wednesday, March 9 at 9:00 pm. They will re-open by Monday, March 14 at 5:00 am.
- The ramp detour route will be SR 139 to Sullivan Road to Clark Howell Highway and back to I-285.
(The detour only applies to motorists driving I-285 eastbound from SR 139 and for motorists who wish to exit from I-285 eastbound to Clark Howell Highway.)
- Westbound traffic on I-285 will not be impacted.
- Some lanes on I-285 eastbound will be closed during the shift, but will re-open by Monday, March 14 at 5:00 am.
