USDA, APHIS, PPQ currently authorizes the following types of plants for planting and herbarium specimens to be imported into Atlanta for inspection and clearance:

- **Aglaonema**
- **Bromeliads from Netherlands**
- **Ferns from the Netherlands**
- **Mandevilla**
- **Poinsettias**
- **Tissue cultured plant materials** of generally admissible plants, including orchids (excludes prohibited plants and those required to be grown in postentry quarantine)

- **Unrooted Cuttings of Herbaceous Plant, such as**

Anthurium
Begonia
Caladium
Coleus
Fuchsia
Geranium

Gerbera
Hosta
Impatiens
Liriope
Pelargonium
Syngonium

- **Herbarium specimens** (excluding normally prohibited items, Federal Noxious Weeds, disease/infested specimens)
